Students need to be **ON TIME** on testing days. We begin testing promptly at 9:00. Students can not enter a testing room once directions have been read and testing has started. Students who are late will be sent to PE and will then have to attend a make up session.

If a student is checked out/leaves campus while they are in a testing session, that testing session will be invalidated and your student will not receive a score. Please make all appointments after 1:00 on testing days.
